If there is an alert for potential adverse effects, the lab will notify the investigator site. Investigators can access the results from these samples via an online system and also have access to other patient data present in our snapClinical® technology platform.

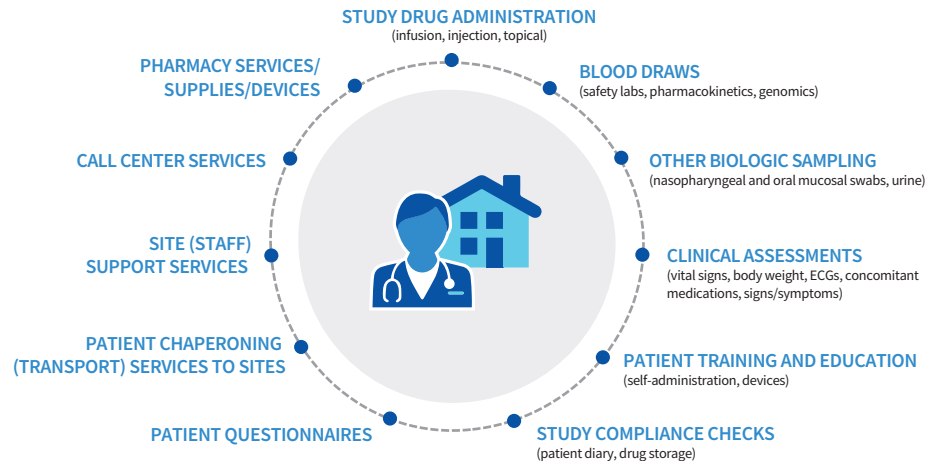
